

Raised on the Island, Ned Hanlan became a World Champion sculler in 1880, and is one of Canada's most loved sports heros of all time. To honour his achievements the City of Toronto erected a monument to Ned Hanlan carved by famed sculptor, Emanuel Hahn in 1926. Formerly on the grounds of the Canadian National Exhibition, this monument has been relocated to the Island that bears his family name.
