Ten minutes from the downtown section to a modern airliner will be the rule in Toronto when the Island

airport is officially opened in a few weeks' time. While Trans-Canada Air Lines have not yet announced

when they will take over the field for regular service, planes are now parked in and about the completed hangar. By the first of May, light-

ing equipment for night flying is expected to be installed. Wiring has been laid underground for beacon and runway lights. Runways are
